Bus Routes

From Dame Siobhain McDonagh, DBE MP for Mitcham and Morden

Many residents have been understandably concerned about the future of the 80, 93, 163, 164 and 470 bus routes following claims made by the Sutton Liberal Democrats.

I wrote directly to Go Ahead London to seek clear assurances about whether these routes were at risk. I am pleased to confirm that these bus routes will not be closing.

Triggering a break clause is a fairly common occurrence that TfL's bus contract team handle routinely and in a way that will have no impact to the customer. No services are being withdrawn, and there will be no disruption for passengers.
